Vacancy: The Woodland Park School District Re-2 is seeking an individual to fill the position of Interim Superintendent of Schools starting immediately. Woodland Park School District is a grade Pre-K through twelve District with approximately 2,100 students.

Salary and Benefits: Contract is for a term expiring on June 30, 2023 with a mutual option to renew for subsequent years. Minimum starting salary at \$145,000 annually based on qualifications and experience (annual salary prorated based upon mid-year start date).
