STAFF DRESS CODE

Teachers and other staff members project an image to the community and to students about the professionalism of the district. During the workday and at all work-related activities, employees shall adhere to a professional standard of dress and shall be neat and clean in appearance. Examples of professional attire include, but are not limited to, collared shirts, dress slacks, ties, dresses and coordinated separates. Hair coloration must be natural hues. The principal has the final authority to decide what is professional attire.

Exceptions

Appropriate athletic clothing may be worn when teaching or assisting with physical education classes, or when coaching athletic activities.

Building principals in conjunction with the school accountability committee may develop and adopt school-specific dress codes that are consistent with this policy.
