WALL COVERINGS

This policy is written with the understanding that educational environments must be free from distractions, and the District should steward taxpayer resources responsibly. In order to provide a consistent, academic, and student-focused learning environment, the following wall covering requirements will be observed:

- All wall coverings must meet fire code;
- Nothing will be permanently hung or displayed on walls;
- Existing features (i.e. shelving, cabinetry, counters, etc.) will not be altered, defaced, or removed without prior approval by the District Facilities Team;
- Wallpaper will not be installed in schools, permanently or temporarily;
- All murals or custom paint colors must be pre-approved by district administration and will be repainted by the classroom teacher prior to leaving for the summer;
- The only flags/banners allowed for display on walls will be that of the United States of America, the State of Colorado, and pendants from institutions of higher education (i.e. alma mater of teacher);
- Temporary displays for a specific educational purpose (i.e. displaying flags of other countries) may be hung with prior approval by district administration and must be removed promptly afterwards.
 - Requests to administration must include at a minimum: where the display will be temporarily installed, what will be displayed, start date and duration of display, and purpose of requested display.
