



MEAL SERVICE FOR IN-PERSON LEARNERS: Effective 8/25/2020

- Meal service at each school (breakfast & lunch) will be 'grab and go' style with both cold and hot options. Students may opt to bring their own lunches.
- There will be no self-serve options or self-services stations available. All fruit and vegetable options will be pre-packaged, and salad bar options will still be offered. At the elementary level, staff serve these items to students from behind the serving line. At secondary schools, there will be pre-packaged fruit and veggies on the salad bars as grab and go items.
- Food service will follow practices and procedures that comply with public health guidelines for food handling, food preparation, and food and drink dispensing, as well as cleaning and disinfecting. High-touch surfaces and high traffic areas are frequently cleaned and sanitized.
- Staff will wear masks and gloves while preparing food, serving food and interacting with students. Food service staff will be required to complete a health survey prior to their shift each day that includes a temperature screening. As always, food service staff will wash their hands frequently.
- When students enter the cafeteria, they will find floor markings, signage, and other space configurations that promote physical distancing.
- Once students have their meals, they will exit past the cashier and will eat with their cohorts in classrooms, the cafeteria, or other designated areas to support proper physical distancing. rt proper physical distancing.
