SENATE BILL NO. 94-004 (Effective July 1, 1994)

HOME-BASED EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN

22-33-104.5 - Home-Based education - legislative declaration - definitions guidelines. The general assembly hereby declares that it is the primary right and obligation of the parent to choose the proper education and training for children under his care and supervision. It is recognized that home-based education is a legitimate alternative to classroom attendance for the instruction of children and that any regulation of non-public home-based educational programs should be sufficiently flexible to accommodate a variety of circumstances. The general assembly further declares that non-public home-based educational programs shall be subject only to minimum state controls which are currently applicable to other forms of non-public education.

Parent is to provide written notification of home-based education program fourteen (14) days prior to the start of the program and each year thereafter if program is maintained.
