The type of preparedness group will need to be predetermined before adding an SGO. Group names should be entered here, separated by commas (i.e. High, Average, Low). The SGO form will be built appropriately using this information. NOTE: Groups may not be added after this screen.

 - Enter **# of Students**
 - **Interval of Instruction** (i.e. School year, Semester, 6 week intervention)
 - Enter **Assessment Method** with required details
 - Enter **Standards & Rationale**

Preparedness Groups represent a group of students that share similar academic and/or learning traits; Designating groups allows the teacher to set differing targets for students based how well prepared they are to meet expectations of the class; This will be prepopulated from the entry page.

In the Dashboard, **ONLY** the bottom of the scoring band (or cut score) should be entered; For example, if the band is 70-80%, enter 70%. This number represents the % of students that will reach the target score. The % for Full should be ambitious, but achievable.
