**BOARD OF EDUCATION**

Board Work Session – October 23, 2019

**CALL TO ORDER**

The work session was called to order by Board President Beth Huber at 5:45 p.m. with the following members present: Chris Austin, Gwynne Dawdy-Pekron, Corbin Graber, Nancy Lecky, and Mrs. Huber.

**BOARD GOVERNANCE**

The Board of Education reviewed GP-2, Board Job Description; GP-6, President's Role; and GP-10, Monitoring Job Performance. No issues and will be on the November meeting consent calendar.

**PULSE CHECK/SURVEY TIMELINE**

Superintendent Steve Woolf explained another survey is required for the Social Emotional Grant due to take place in November and requested the pulse check surveys be moved to early December. The Board of Education was in agreement and the surveys will be distributed right after Thanksgiving. All the surveys were reviewed.

**BULLY PARENTS**

Superintendent Woolf provided the revised Public Conduct on District Property policy for the Board to review. Discussion regarding examples of the types of parent misconduct were discussed. Beth Huber suggested that the Colorado 18-9-111 C.R.S. -- Harassment / Kiana Arellano's law be added as Legal Ref on the Policy. Chris Austin suggested reminding staff of what resources, training, self-advocating is available to them. Gwynne Dawdy-Pekron added that EAP and Welco have resources to help.

**SALES TAX/OUTREACH PRESENTATION**

Nancy Lecky indicated that she had reached out to the Democratic Party and the Senior Center with no response to date. Gwynne will contact the Republican Party to reschedule for their Dec or Jan meeting. Steve Woolf indicated 10-15 minutes on their agenda is all that is needed.

**DISTRICT COMPUTER UPDATE**

Superintendent Woolf shared that the District has a new Backup system in place in the Cloud to ensure WPSD data can be recovered in event of a ransomware attack. Nancy Lecky suggested that cyber security awareness information be shared with staff. She will send an example.

**WORD ON THE STREET**


